

COOKIES POLICY

Applicable laws and regulations

Section 22.2 of the Information Society Services and Electronic Commerce Act 34/2002 of 11 July (ISS&EC Act) provides as follows:

Service providers may use data storage and recovery devices in user terminal equipment provided users have given their consent after being provided with clear, complete information on their use, particularly the purpose of processing the data, pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Act, Organic Law 15/1999 of 13 December.

Whenever it is technically possible and effective, users' consent to the processing of their data may be given using the adequate parameters of the browser or other applications, provided users must set them up during installation or update by means of an express action.

The foregoing will prevent the possible storage or technical access for the sole purpose of transferring a communication through a network of electronic communications or, insofar as may be strictly necessary, to provide an information society service expressly requested by the user.

According to the "Guidelines on the use of cookies" published by the Spanish Data Protection Agency (AEPD) in 2013, the ISS&EC Act is applicable to any file or device downloaded in users' terminal equipment for the purpose of storing data which may be updated and recovered by the entity responsible for its installation. Cookies are one of those devices which is in widespread use, so we shall hereinafter refer to all those devices generally as cookies.

Cookies used for the following purposes are excluded from fulfilment of the obligations established in section 22.2 of the ISS&EC Act:

- Those used solely to enable communication between the user's equipment and the web.
- Those used strictly to provide a service expressly requested by the user.

1. TYPES OF COOKIES ACCORDING TO PURPOSE

A cookie is a file that is downloaded onto your computer when you access certain websites. Cookies enable a site, among other things, to store and recover information on the surfing habits of a user or equipment and, depending on the information they contain and how they use your equipment, they may be used to recognise the user.

As indicated in the "Guidelines on the use of cookies" of the AEPD, depending on the purpose for which the details obtained through cookies are used, we can distinguish between:

Technical cookies: Enable users to surf a website, platform or application and use the different options or services provided, such as controlling the traffic and communication of data, identifying the session, accessing parts with restricted access, recalling the items making up an order, effecting the

purchase process of an order, making a request for registration or participation in an event, using security elements during browsing, storing contents for the distribution of videos or audio or sharing contents through the social networks.

Personalisation cookies: Enable users to access the service with certain pre-defined general features according to a number of criteria in the users' terminal equipment, such as language, type of browser used to access the service, regional set-up from which the service is accessed, etc.

Analysis cookies: Enable the controller of the cookies to monitor and analyse the behaviour of users of the websites to which they are linked. The information collected by this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the website, application or platform and to establish the navigation profiles of users of those sites, applications and platforms with a view to making improvements based on the analysis made of the use made by users of the service.

Advertising cookies: Enable the most efficient management of advertising spaces that the publisher may have included in a website, application or platform from which the requested service is provided, based on criteria such as edited contents or the frequency with which the advertisements are shown.

Tracking advertising Cookies: Enable the most efficient management of advertising spaces that the publisher may have included in a website, application or platform from which the requested service is provided. These cookies store information on user behaviour obtained by continuous observation of their surfing habits, thus enabling the development of a specific profile for showing advertising based on that behaviour.

2. PRINCIPLE OF INFORMATION

In pursuance of section 5 of the Personal Data Protection Act, Organic Law 15/1999 of 13 December (LOPD), you are expressly, precisely and unequivocally advised that the information obtained through the cookies installed on your computer will be used **to guarantee the quality, security and improvement of the services offered.**

3. PRINCIPLE OF CONSENT

Consent for installing cookies will be deemed given by marking the box for accepting the “Cookies Policy” provided on our website.

If users do not expressly indicate whether they accept the installation of cookies, but continue to use the website or application, they will be considered to have given their consent. Our company expressly advises users of the possibility of blocking or deleting cookies installed on their equipment through the options set-up of their browser.

4. OPTIONAL INSTALLATION OF COOKIES

Although acceptance of the installation of cookies on your computer is optional, refusal to allow such installation may lead to limited or impossible use of the website, which would make it impossible for our company to provide services through it.

5. EXERCISE OF RIGHTS

In pursuance of the LOPD and Royal Decree 1720/2007 of 21 December approving the corresponding Regulations, users of the service may at any time exercise their rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition by contacting the data controller and enclosing a photocopy of their identity document.
